

Self-Financing Scheme for Foreign Students from friendly developing countries for the academic session 2016-17

Eligibility/Guidelines for applicants

Applications to be submitted in triplicate through the Indian diplomatic representation in the country of candidate's domicile.

Eligibility criteria for various courses:

(a) For admission to MBBS/BDS courses: A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India - equivalence certificate from AIU, New Delhi as requested in para 3(ii) above must be enclosed).

(b) For B.E.course: A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard in India)

(c) For B.Pharmacy/Diploma in Pharmacy courses: A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard in India).

(d) For Diploma in Engineering Course: A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics separately in the first attempt and 50% in English in 10th as well in 12th Grade examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard in India).

It may please be noted that for admission to 1st year Diploma in Engineering course, the age limit of the candidate should be below 21 years as on 1.8.2016.

Three recent photographs of candidate **duly attested by the Mission/Post** pasted at prescribed places in the application.

Three sets of attested copies of candidate's certificates and marks sheets with percentage of marks of the qualifying examination.

Three **attested copies** of candidate's:

- a) bio pages of the passport;
- b) citizenship certificate; or birth certificate;
- c) character certificate from the Head of Institution last attended.

Applicants may please be advised that merely forwarding their applications should not be treated as assurance for their nomination by the Ministry. The Ministry will scrutinize all the applications and only after these are found complete in all respects, the names of the eligible applicants will be considered for nomination in the order of merit and preference for the course.

Selected candidates are expected to comply with admission formalities and procedures of the respective colleges/universities. These may include specific medical examinations including Aids test in India.
