

HIGH COMMISSION OF INDIA

THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER THE ICCR SCHEMES OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA HAS BEEN EXTENDED UP TO MAY 31, 2022.

The submission of applications for Scholarships under the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) Schemes, of Government of India for the academic session 2022- 2023, **is open** for the following Schemes:

- **1. Commonwealth Scholarship Plan** Nine scholarships are available under this programme, for Guyanese Nationals, with tuition, stipend, contingent grant, house rent allowance/ accommodation, thesis, dissertation expenses and return international airfare covered by the Government of India for Undergraduate, Post-Graduate and Post-Doctoral Research Courses. The Scholarship does not offer admission in Medical/ Paramedical (Nursing/ Physiotherapy/ Anesthesia etc.)/ fashion course.
- **2. ICCR Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture** This Scholarship Scheme, encompassing wider facets of Indian Culture, not just limited to dance and music but also to performing art, theatre, sculpture, Indian cuisine etc. This scholarship is **first come**, **first serve basis**, with **return economy class airfare** to the nearest airport and 3rd AC Train fare to the place of study, if so required.
- **3. Cultural Exchange Programme/Education Exchange Programme -** Two scholarships are available under this programme **without airfare**.

Instructions:

- 1. It is important that all prospective applicants read the guidelines before applying for a Course. Guidelines can be viewed at http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/assets/site/docs/Policy%20Guidelines.pdf. Kindly visit the websites of preferred Universities/Institutes and do thorough research of Courses offered, the eligibility criteria and general information about the University/Institute before applying for admission. The applicants should ensure that they are eligible for the Courses and submit relevant documentations as required by the Universities/Institutes. Applicant must be 18 years at the time of admission and not more than 30 years of age.
- 2. Applications are to be filled online at http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/home/register. A recent passport size photograph (not more than 3.5 x 4.5cm i.e 25kb) should be uploaded on the application form. Copies of all academic qualifications, certificates and mark sheets, including those relating to school leaving examination along with a certificate of physical fitness in the prescribed form, recommendations/character certificates from existing school as required by the Universities and certified copy of bio-data page of applicant's valid passport are to be uploaded also. A printed and signed copy of the Application along with copies of all documents uploaded are also to be submitted to High Commission of India not later than May 31, 2022.
