For Foreigners of Indian Origin (persons not born in India)

- 1. Get all required birth certificates from the General Birth Registration Office (for applicant and ancestors)
- 2. Collect Immigration Pass (for ancestor who came from India) from the Nationals Archives (or relevant body)
- 3. Get all birth certificates/marriage certificates/immigration pass attested (stamped and signed) by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or responsible authority
- 4. Complete the application online: https://ociservices.gov.in/
- 5. Upload all requisite documents:
 - Coloured Photograph (2 inch by 2 inch size)
 - Scanned Signature
 - Foreign Passport
 - Birth Certificates (of applicant and ancestors)
 - Marriage Certificate where necessary
 - Immigration Pass (of Ancestors who came from India)
- 6. Print application and attach all undermentioned documents:
 - Form duly signed by the applicant and in case of applications for minors, applications should be signed by parents
 - Copy of all documents stated in no. 2 along with originals (and the attested relevant documents by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs)
 - 2 coloured photographs (2 inch by 2 inch size photograph) and sample signatures on a blank page
 - Fee:
